Facts from Okland Construction

- Building Size: 143,000 square feet
- Cubic Yards of Concrete: 8,486 cubic yards (building concrete)
- Tons of Structural Steel: 710 tons
- Tons of Joists: 965 tons
- Tons of Reinforcing Steel: 450 tons
- Glazed Curtain Wall: 44,100 square feet
- Metal Wall Panels: 36,530 square feet
- Brick: 160,000 individual bricks
- Length of Conduit and Wire: 14.20 miles of conduit and 65.34 miles of wire
- Length of Plumbing Pipe: 6 miles of pipe
- Tons of Ductwork: 90 tons of ductwork

- The Utah Valley Convention Center will open spring 2012.
- The Utah Valley Convention Center is the first venue of its kind in the area.
- The Utah Valley Convention Center comes after years of research and careful planning by community leaders.
- With 52,000 square feet of meeting space, the Convention Center will draw and accommodate large groups, which will also increase spending in Utah Valley.
- The Utah Valley Convention Center will be a LEED Silver-certified building, which means that its design, construction, operation and maintenance will be environmentally friendly and economically sensible.
- Funding for the Utah Valley Convention Center was secured through a government bond with a historic low interest rate of 3.87 percent.
- The UVCVB projects total economic impact of up to \$18 million, generated by group activities and events held at the Utah Valley Convention Center.
- The Utah Valley Convention Center is located on 220 West Center Street in Provo, Utah.
