### LaVell Edwards Stadium

Capacity: 64,045

LaVell Edwards Stadium, with its 64,045-seat capacity, huge video scoreboards and immaculate press boxes, is home to legendary BYU football. Some of the stadium's well-known features include a box-bowl seating configuration, a grass playing surface and a four-level press box. The well-kept grass field is consistently deemed one of the best in the country.

### Marriott Center

Capacity: 22,700

The Marriott Center features seven locker rooms, a President's room, two reception rooms, press and interview rooms, men's and women's team rooms and a training room. Upgrades made in 2006 included installing a new state-of-the-art Connor Sports floor. "The Marriott Center is one of the top five places to play in the country, not just because of its size, but because its facilities are fantastic," said former UTEP head coach Don Haskins, "If there is a better arena, I haven't seen it."

### Miller Park

Capacity: 2,204

Larry H. Miller Field at Miller Park was featured in February of the 2002 Great Parks Calendar provided by Baseball America. It was also among the featured facilities in the October 2001 Athletics Administration magazine.

There are separate locker rooms for visitors and Cougar clubhouses for both softball and baseball. The complex includes concession stands, an elevator, an umpire room, a hosting facility, an equipment room, training room, double-wide indoor batting cages and coaches' offices. Both fields are lighted.

## George Albert Smith Fieldhouse

Capacity: 5,000

The George Albert Smith Fieldhouse is one of the finest volleyball facilities in the nation. It is home to the BYU men's and women's volleyball teams, two of the nation's winningest NCAA volleyball programs, and the BYU women's gymnastics team. The facility has annually hosted the country's top teams and has also been the sight of many NCAA Tournament matches since the inception of the women's competition in 1981

## Clarence F. Robison Track

Capacity: 2,000

The nationally acclaimed Clarence F. Robison track is the home of the BYU men's and women's track teams. Coaches and athletes rate BYU's outdoor track as one of the finest in the nation. Its compact design allows spectators to view both running and field competitions at the same venue. With the majestic backdrop of the Wasatch Mountains, the Clarence F. Robison Track is a picturesque setting for all events.

## Stephen L. Richards Building

The facility includes three Olympic-size heated swimming pools to serve as the home for BYU's men's and women's swimming and diving teams. Pool facilities include aluminum diving boards, under-water lighting, observation and photography windows, permanent racing lanes and equipment for beginning swimmers and family groups.

### McKay Events Center

Capacity: 8,500

This versatile facility is great for sporting events, concerts and tradeshow. Event services include linens, floral, signs and displays, and support staff. Full equipment rental services are available including tables and chairs, portable stage or basketball floor, and sound and light systems.

### Brent Brown Ballpark

Capacity: 2,500

The Brent Brown Ballpark boasts both home and visitor clubhouses and batting cages, Gold's Gym inside the stadium and a state of the art scoreboard that make it one of the top college baseball facilities in the nation. Beyond the left field wall, the Utah Valley State campus and the Wasatch Mountains provide the park with a beautiful backdrop.
